Title of Session IS09:

Simulation and Visualization/VR for Medicine

Name, Title and Affiliation of Chair:

Details of Session (including aim and scope):

Computer simulation plays important roles in modern medical researches. For example, simulations are often executed for surgical operations, vascular flows, heart pulsation, breathing, and so forth. Many research groups are executing large-scale medical simulations by using massive computer powers. It has been recognized well that computer visualization is inevitable to investigate the simulation results. For example, volume/surface visualization, flow visualization, visual data fusion, and information visualization are often used coupled with medical simulation. Virtual-reality techniques are also used in medical visualization. In this session, papers on both simulation and visualization/VR can be submitted. This policy aims at exchanging ideas of different but mutually dependent research fields.

The required paper length is 10 pages in publisher format. Papers longer than this may be subject to an additional charge. Papers much longer or shorter than the required length may be rejected, at the decision of the organisers.
